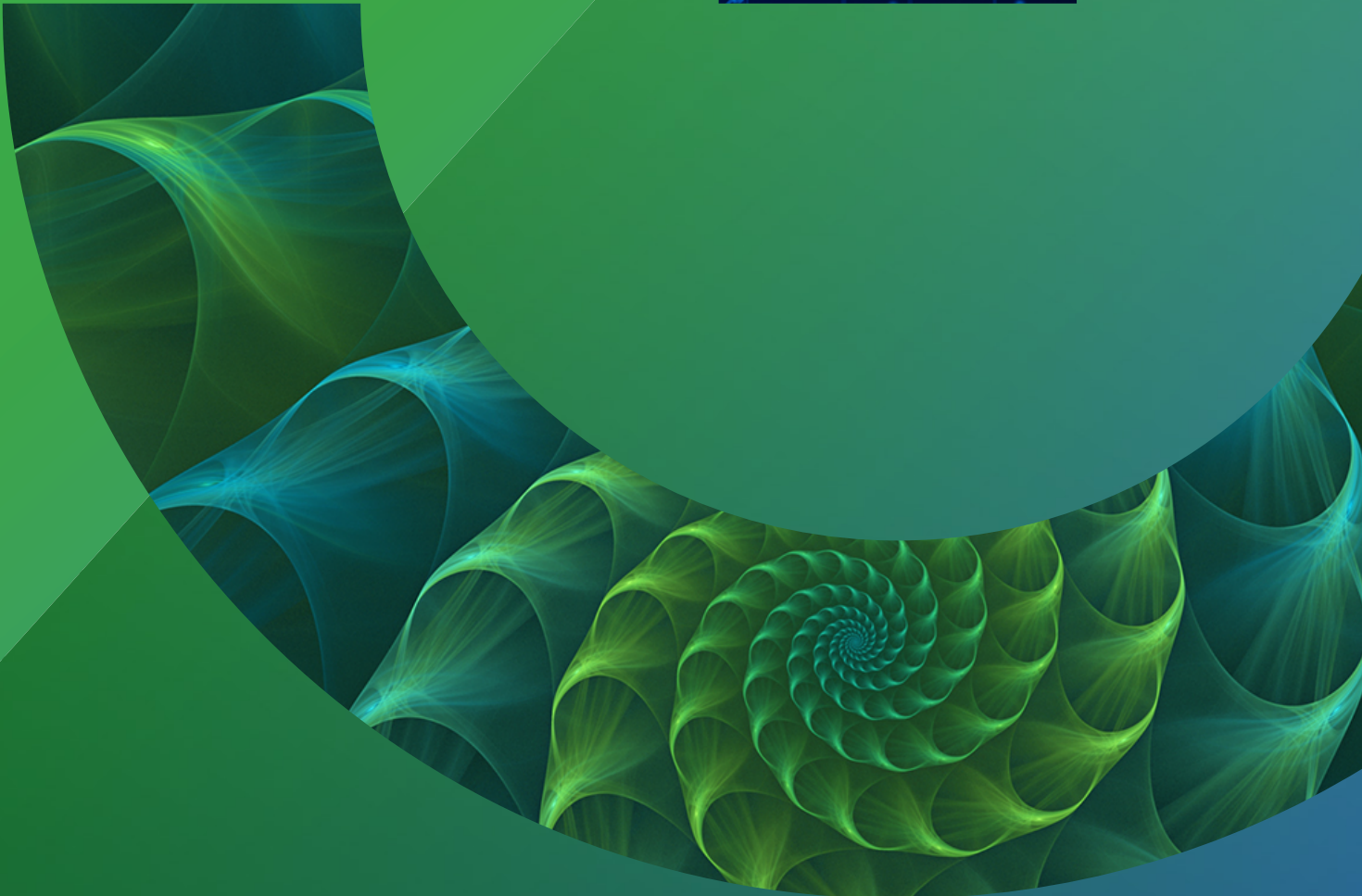

## Virtual Networking Roundtables

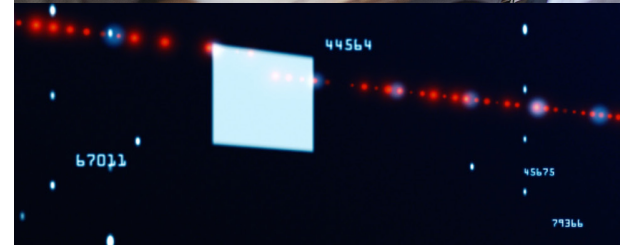
